### HEADMASTER'S KEY NOTICES

#### **END OF TERM - ANNUAL CHRISTMAS SERVICE**

On the last day of term, Friday 21st December, the School walks to the Oratory Church for the Annual Christmas Service at 2pm. Pupils will be dismissed from the Oratory Church at 3pm except for Junior House pupils who will be returning to School. Please check that your son or daughter knows how to travel home from the Oratory and make sure that they have enough money to pay any additional fares.

Because it is difficult to seat the whole school at the Church, pupils in the fifth form and lower-sixth, who are not required for duties, will not be required to attend for the day. Owing to space constraints, we are unable to accommodate parents of pupils at the service. Pupils who will be attending the service must bring their service books to school for the service. All pupils should bring a school raincoat or school jacket.
